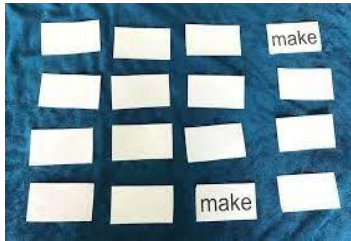


K20 - Term 3 Week 2- Choice Board: Choose 1 activity from each section, per day.

Literacy Activities

Sight Word- Go
Fish/Memory Games
Use the cut up cards to play a game of go-fish or memory.



Play-Doh Letters:
Use play-doh to make your sounds and sight words.



Rainbow writing:
Use different coloured textas or pencils to write your sounds and sight words.



Cotton Bud Painting/ Finger Painting:
Write your sounds and sight words with your finger or cotton buds.

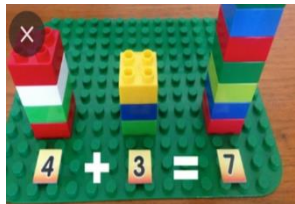


Rice or Sprinkles:
Put some rice or sprinkles into a container and use your fingers to draw your sounds and sight words.



Numeracy Activities and Games:

Roll and Build Activity 1:
Roll 1 or 2 dice and then use that number to build 2 towers.
Eg. 7 can be made with one tower of 4 and one tower of 3.
Extension: Write the number sentence for your building:
Eg. $4 + 3 = 7$
Note: you can do this with toys or blocks or anything you have at home.



Dice Counting:
Use a die, objects for counting and a cup. Roll the dice and add objects to the cup. See who can fill the cup first.



Friends of 10 Memory:
You will need a deck of cards (1-10 only) or Uno cards (1-10 only)
Take turns, turning over 2 cards, if they add to 10, keep them. If not, turn them back over and swap turns.

Roll and Build Activity 2:
Roll 1 or 2 dice and then use that number to build 3 towers.
Eg. 7 can be made with one tower of 4 and one tower of 1 and one tower of 2.

Extension: Write the number sentence for your building:
Eg. $4 + 1 + 2 = 7$



Note: You can do this with toys or blocks or anything you have at home.

Creative Arts: Vv Volcano Art – see Creative Arts Worksheet

Equipment Needed:
Volcano coloured
paints, paint brush

1. Paint the palm with the fire/lava colours or yellow, orange, and red. Paint the base of the hand yellow, the middle orange, and the fingers red.
2. Make a handprint near the top centre of the page, with fingers pointing upwards. This will be the lava coming out from the top of the volcano.
3. Use a paintbrush and brown or black paint to paint the main part of the volcano.

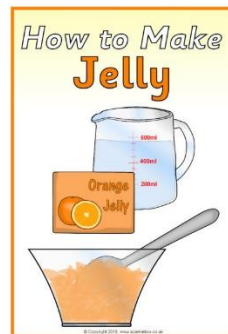
Note: This can be made with crayons/pencil instead of paint.

 4. Race with a family member for 1 minute- who won?
- Repeat the 1-minute challenges as many times as you can in 20 minutes.



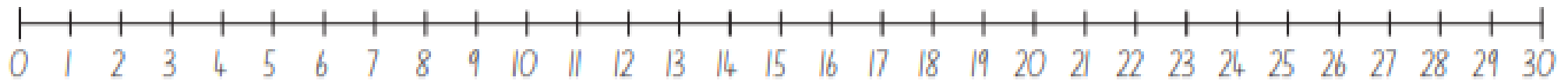
Creative Arts: Jj is for Jelly Fish

Equipment Needed:
paint, scissors, googly eyes (optional)

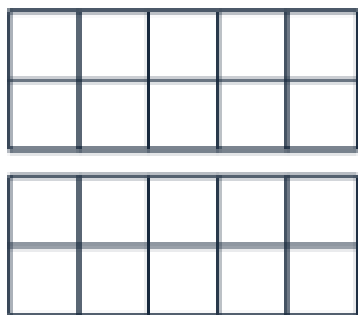
1. Paint the jellyfish pattern. Leave to dry. After the jellyfish has dried, cut it out.
2. Cut and glue the letter J onto a piece of paper. Leave plenty of space at the top.
3. Cut out the jellyfish pieces. Glue the tentacles so that they hang down from the top of the J.
4. Glue down the jellyfish's head.
5. Put down two dots of glue for the eyes. Add two googly eyes (or draw them on).

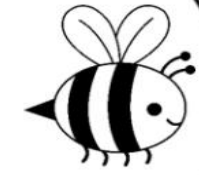
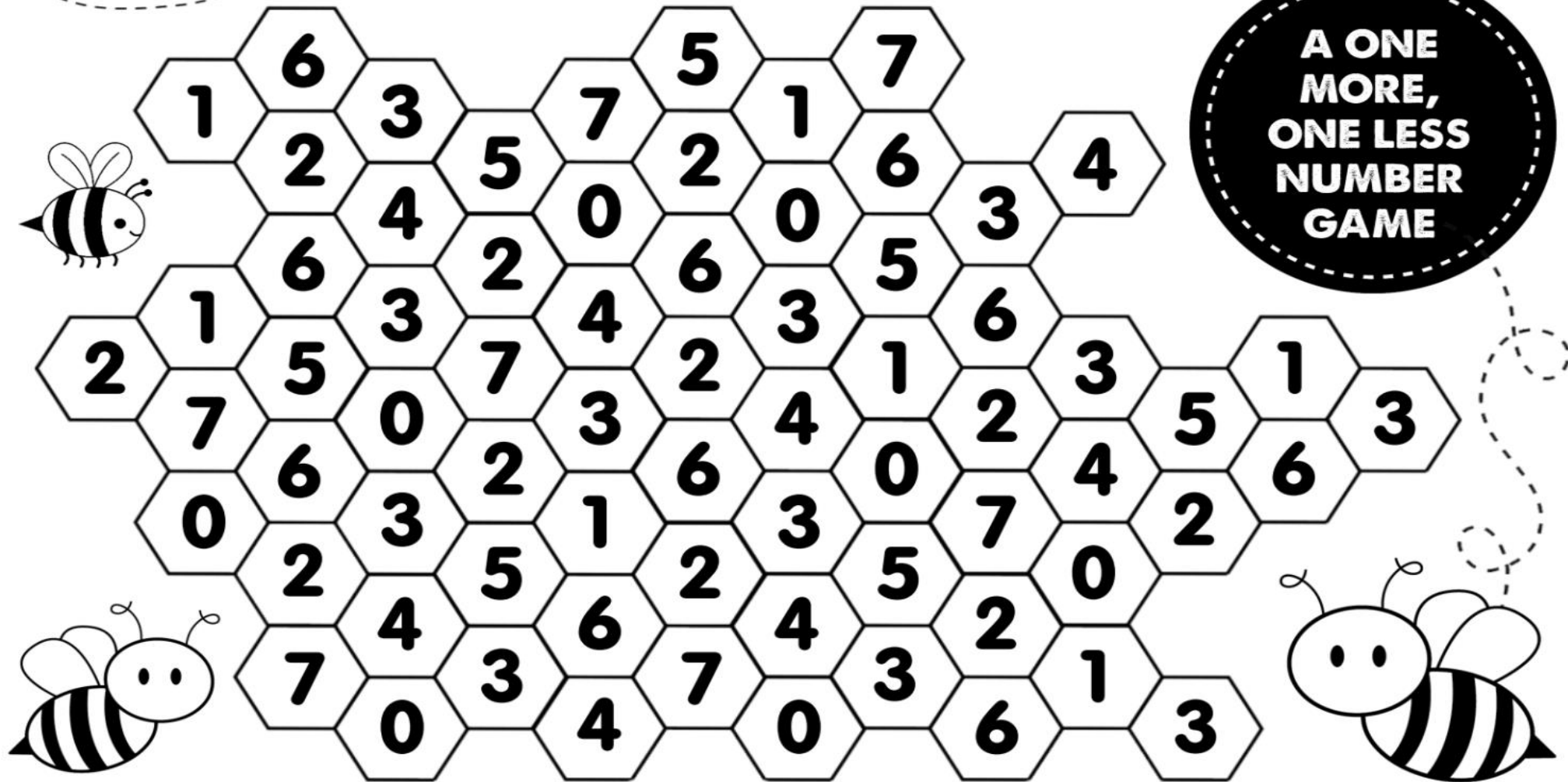
Roll 2 dice. Add them together. Place a counter on the correct answer. If an answer is already covered, place a counter on top. The winner is the first person to fill their board.
