I hope the following information may answer some of your many questions regarding the start of school in 2022.

STUDENTS

- Students commencing **Year 1- 6 to start Tuesday**, **1**st **February 2022**. These students will return to their 2021 classes for the morning session
- Support classes will operate from Wednesday, 2nd February 2022 as per communication already sent home in 2021
- **Kinder students 2022 will participate in BEST START** as per letters sent home end of 2021
 - **Please note due to current COVID-19 restrictions, our Buddy Day organised for Friday, 5th February 2022 has been cancelled**
- All Kindergarten students will commence full time from Monday, 8th February 2022

UNIFORMS

• Excel uniform providers will be onsite the following days:

PARENTS

- All parents entering school grounds must wear a mask, **must** be vaccinated and check in via QR code
- Parents can only be onsite for administration purposes

PICK UP AND DISMISSAL

- Students are to be dropped each morning and dismissed via our three main gates
- Kinder Year 2 will be dismissed at 2.50pm followed by Years 3 6 at 3pm
- Please note special rules for this will apply to new Kindergarten students for first fortnight only

CANTEEN

- Kids Pantry, our canteen provider, will be commencing from **Thursday**, **3**rd **January 2022**.
- They would prefer online ordering, however purchases can still be made over the counter

RAT KITS

- Parents/Caregivers are able to pick up RAT kits from our school hall on Friday, 28th & Monday, 31st Jan 2022 between school hours.
- Parents/caregivers are to use the provided kits to verify that students are COVID-19 free
- The Education Department has suggested twice weekly (Mondays & Wednesdays)
- Results are for parent use only
- It is anticipated that these tests will be for the first four weeks of the school year
- A positive COVID-19 case of a student must be immediately notified to the school and reported to the Health Department through Services NSW portal
- Parents will be provided with details regarding a positive COVID-19 case that may impact on a cohort group
- School should be notified if students are household close contacts must isolate at home for 7 days.
- Our Department has provided a Learning From Home portal for access should students require LFH materials or resources

MASKS

- Masks must be worn by all adults whilst on school premises
- The Department has suggested mask wearing for older students in Stage 2 and 3, however this not mandatory

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- To assist with COVID safe guidelines, our students will operate in cohorts. At Blackwell, this means stages.
- Each stage will maintain their own playground areas and be kept as separate groups for curriculum activities such as sport and library

VACCINATION

- Students and their families are strongly encouraged to be fully vaccinated
- All staff at Blackwell are fully vaccinated in order to be onsite

SCHOOL AUDIT

- Our school was audited in 2021 to ensure we have appropriate ventilation and learning spaces available to our students and staff
- We have been assured that air purifiers will be provided if needed
